Application Form

You may be eligible for up to three FREE High-Efficiency Toilets (HETs)! HETs are a new generation of toilets that use 20% less water than a standard low-flow toilet. LOTT pays for the toilet(s); you pay for installation by a plumber of your choice or install it yourself. We are offering three different toilet technologies – you choose the one that will best meet your needs.

To be eligible, you must:

- Install the toilet(s) in a residence that receives LOTT sewer service from one of the three Cities: Lacey, Olympia, or Tumwater
- Replace an existing toilet(s) that use 3.0 gallons or more per flush
- Complete this application, including the attached toilet measurement form; attach a copy of your City utility bill showing your account number; and return it to:

3. LOTT and its partner cities of Lacey, Olympia, or Tumwater reserve the right to verify installation. Participants may also be contacted by telephone to arrange a site visit to verify installation and to inquire about program satisfaction.

All products, services, and labor are the responsibility of the manufacturer and/or contractor. Toilet Measurement Form

Instructions

Please fill in the table below, taking measurements for each of the toilets you wish to replace through this program. See the photo for reference.

If your toilet is marked with a stamp of 1.6 gpf, further measurements are not necessary. If your toilet is not stamped, remove the lid from the toilet tank and take the following measurements inside the tank, resting the metal tab of the tape measure against the inside edge of tank. All measurements should be in inches.

1. Length – Measure the inside of the tank side to side. (If tank is not uniformly rectangular, provide an average of the lengths near the top of the water line and at the bottom.)
2. Width – Measure the inside of the toilet tank front to back.
3. Depth 1 – Set the metal end of the measuring tape down at the bottom of the tank to record the height of the water present when the tank is full.
4. Depth 2 – Keeping the measuring tape in the same position (metal end at the tank bottom), flush the toilet. Record the inches of water when the tank is at its lowest.
