

# Construction News

January 2010

**Excavation and heavy construction work is set to begin the week of January 11, 2010.  
Expect a detour on Old Mottman Court and increased truck traffic.  
Businesses on Old Mottman Court will be accessible via the detour.**

## About the Project

The LOTT Alliance is replacing a sewer interceptor pipeline that has been threatened by erosion along Percival Creek near Old Mottman Court. The project involves boring underground to install two new sections of pipeline, effectively shifting the pipeline away from the creek to protect it from future erosion. This project was identified as an emergency following severe sloughing of the streambank after heavy rains last winter. A temporary overland sewer bypass has been in place since then to provide an alternative sewer route in case of emergency should erosion cause a failure of the original pipeline. This project will provide a long-term solution to the problem and eliminate the need for the overland bypass. Donovan Excavating, of Sumner, Washington is the general contractor for the project, and Gonzales Boring is the subcontractor for the boring work. The project is scheduled for completion in March 2010.



## Location of the Work

The construction work will occur along Old Mottman Court, between RW Johnson Boulevard and Percival Creek. Three boring pits will be constructed: one in the right-of-way near the railroad tracks along RW Johnson, one in the roadway of Old Mottman Court, and another adjacent to an existing sewer manhole near Percival Creek, behind Tires, Inc.

## Traffic Impacts and Access to Businesses Along Old Mottman Court

Most of the construction work will take place in the right-of-way and areas outside the flow of traffic. However, traffic on Old Mottman Court will be impacted intermittently. Access to businesses such as Gymnastics Elite and Alexis Driving School will be provided through a temporary detour along the side of the roadway. Traffic along RW Johnson Boulevard may be restricted to one lane occasionally to accommodate loading and unloading of materials. Signage and flaggers will guide traffic as needed.
